Reopening of Physical Classes in Phase 3 (Heightened Alert)

Thank you for your continued partnership and support. In line with the nation's calibrated transition to Phase 3 (Heightened Alert), Edufront Learning Centre will resume our physical classes from 1 July 2021 (Thursday) if the local COVID-19 cases remain under control in the coming days. Mandatory TraceTogether-only Safe Entry (TOS)

Safe Management Measure @ Edufront

To ensure that the learning experience at Edufront continues safely for our students, parents, teachers and staff, we have implemented the following safety measures:

Safe Entry and Screening

- Trace/Trace Together app only for Safe Entry
- Temperature taking
- Quick health assessment (Students who appear unwell will not be allowed in)
- Hand sanitising

Queue and Crowd Management

- Social distancing while waiting
- Prompt pick-up & drop-off by parents
- Cashless/online payment

Cleanliness and Hygiene

- Wears face mask at all time
- Regular disinfection of classrooms and high-touch surfaces

Classroom Management

- Staggered reporting and dismissal
- No intermingling across classes/ groups

Health Declaration

In line with MOE's advisory, your child will not be permitted to attend physical lessons or enter the centre if he/she:

- a. has been placed on Leave of Absence (LOA) or Approved Absence (AA) by his/her school, or
- b. is on Stay Home Notice (SHN), or Home Quarantine Order (HQO).

We also seek your kind understanding and cooperation to not let your child attend physical classes at our centres if he/she is having fever or respiratory symptoms, such as sneezing, coughing, loss of smell, breathlessness or sore throat. If your child displays such symptoms while in our centres, you will be contacted to bring your child to see a doctor immediately. If any family members living in the same household is unwell, do also keep your child home during this period of heightened alert.
