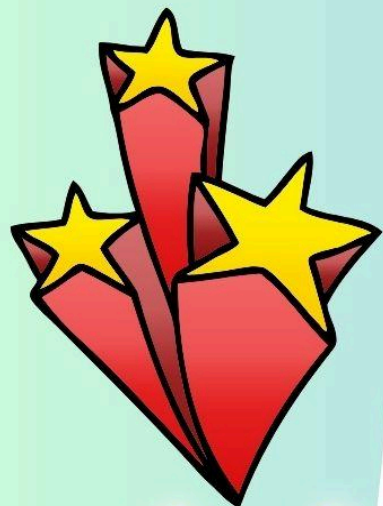

We are offering the following Mastery Programmes in AY2026:

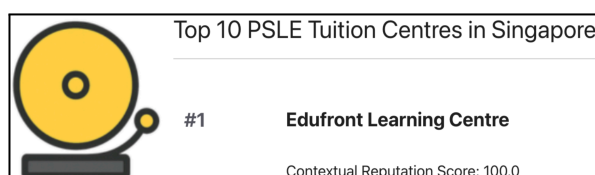

## **Key Programmes in 2026**

### **1. 2026 PSLE Integrated Preparatory Programme**

We have designed a comprehensive and integrated programme to prepare students for the 2026 PSLE. Key features of this programme are

### **2. P3 to P6 Malay Weekly Karangan Mastery Programme**

We introduced our new P3 to P6 Malay (Karangan (Writing)) weekly programme for AY2026. All our weekly Malay programmes are 1.5 hours long. While this duration is sufficient for most subject areas, Malay - like English - has multiple components that assess very different language skills in the PSLE:

1. Karangan (Continuous Writing)
2. Kefahaman (Comprehension – MCQ & Open-Ended)
3. Tatabahasa (Grammar & Vocabulary)
4. Lisan (Oral)

Each component requires a very different set of strategies and practices. For example, writing a composition (Karangan) demands sustained time for idea generation, planning, writing, and teacher feedback. In contrast, comprehension and grammar practice involve analysing passages, answering questions, and reinforcing language rules.

By separating Karangan from the other components, students get the best of both papers:

- Dedicated Karangan sessions: More time for planning, writing, rewriting, and receiving personalised feedback from the teacher.

- Focused Language & Comprehension sessions: Targeted practice in grammar, vocabulary, comprehension, and oral strategies without being rushed.

This structure allows students to build their skills progressively and confidently in each area, giving them a stronger foundation to excel in PSLE Malay.

### 3. G2 & G3 Stream-Specific Classes for Secondary Malay Programme

Our Secondary Malay Programme is now offered in stream-specific classes to better cater to students' learning needs and MOE syllabus requirements.

From this academic year onwards, classes will be organised as follows:

- G2 Stream: For students taking Malay Language (G2 ML)
- G3 Stream: For students taking Malay Language (G3 ML / IP-HML / G3-HML)

This structured approach allows our tutors to deliver more targeted lessons, provide differentiated support, and ensure that students are fully prepared for their respective school examinations.



### Edulabs School Management System

Alternatively, you may also continue to make payment via bank transfer, or NETS at our centres. This enhancement aims to make the payment process faster, easier, and more seamless for all parents. We appreciate your kind cooperation and support as we roll out this new system.

## **Important Administrative Matters**

All students registered into any of our programmes are bound by our terms and conditions as indicated on our website and in the registration forms. We would like to highlight the key points:

### **1. Absence/Make-up Lesson Policy**

- It is the responsibility of the student or parent/guardian to inform the centre of any absences.
- Students absent for reasons other than medical or official events must arrange a make-up lesson within one week of the missed lesson.
- If a similar class is unavailable, a make-up lesson at another branch may be arranged, subject to availability.
- Students in physical lessons may attend the next available physical or online lesson.
- Online lesson students may attend the next available physical lesson or access recorded lessons.
- Tutors are not obligated to conduct separate make-up classes or reteach material to students.

- Make-up lessons are subject to the tutor's goodwill and availability to assist students during the lesson.
- No tuition fee refunds will be given for any absences for make-up lessons.

## **2. Fees Policy**

- Tuition Fee Payment: Tuition fees must be paid within the first week of each month. Extensions may be granted for valid reasons, subject to management approval.
- In the event that tuition fees are not made within the month, students may not be allowed entry to following month's classes until full fee payment is made.
- There will be a deposit fee of \$50 per programme upon registration. This amount will be offset from the last month's fee. In the scenario where the student withdraws without a month's notice, the deposit fee will be forfeited.
- All payment of fees are non-refundable.
- In cases of withdrawal for half-year and annual fee payments, all paid fees remain non-refundable except for the \$50 Refundable Deposit.

## **3. Discount Policy**

- Students will be entitled to the following multiple subjects discount (2 subjects - 5% discount, 3 subjects - 10% discount, 4 subjects - 15% discount, 5 or more subjects – 20% discount)
- Students who have siblings will also be entitled to the multiple subject discount. (e.g. 2 siblings taking 1 subject each will be entitled to a 5% discount each)
- An additional 2% and 5% discount is available for half-year and annual fee payments respectively.
- Discounts may vary based on the number of subjects taken during the academic year.
- Special prices, offers, or discounts may also apply to specific students with prior approval from management.

## **4. Cashless Payment**

- Parents will receive an invoice issued from Edufront Learning Centre on the fees payable each month via email (donotreply@edufront.com).
- Parents may either scan the dynamic QR code via a banking app or screenshot the dynamic QR code and upload it on the banking app. The QR code generates a unique Bill Reference number for the specific invoice.
- Alternatively, parents can make payments via NETS at the counter at any of our physical branches.
